

DATA MANAGEMENT INFORMATION

For the processing of data concerning the participants of the **Solar Boat Challenge** to be organized by the University of Pannonia

between **28-30 August 2026**.

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 95/46/EC (hereinafter: GDPR), the University of Pannonia informs you, as a participant of the **Solar Boat Challenge** (hereinafter: data subject), about the processing of your data by the University of Pannonia.

The controller of the personal data is the University of Pannonia (hereinafter referred to as the "Controller")

The purpose of data processing is: Registration, event documentation

Scope of personal data processed:

- name, signature
- Image and sound recording

Legal basis for processing:

consent of the data subject pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR

Duration of storage of personal data: 1 year from the date of provision of the data the image and sound recording will be published by the University of Pannonia, in particular uploaded to the online platform of the Data Controller

Source of the personal data: data provided by the data subject.

Information on transfer: Personal data will not be transferred. No automated decision-making and profiling will take place during the processing.

Right of access to personal data: you may request information on whether the Controller is processing your personal data; if it is, you may request a copy of the personal data processed.

Right to rectification: you may request the Controller to rectify inaccurate personal data relating to you without undue delay and to complete incomplete personal data processed.

Information about your rights in relation to data processing.

Right of access to personal data: You may request information as to whether the Data Controller is processing your personal data; if so, you may request a copy of the personal data processed.

Right to rectification: You may request that the Data Controller rectify inaccurate personal data concerning you without undue delay, and may request that incomplete personal data of the data subject be completed.

Right to restriction of data processing: You may request that the Data Controller only stores your personal data/part of your personal data and does not perform any other data processing operations (such as use, disclosure, transmission). You may request the restriction of data processing for the following reasons:

- You dispute the accuracy of the personal data,
- the processing is unlawful and you oppose the erasure of the data,
- the Controller no longer needs the personal data, but you require them for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims,
- you have objected to the processing, in which case the restriction shall apply for a period of time until it is established whether the legitimate grounds of the Controller override your legitimate grounds.

Right to object

You may object at any time to the processing of your personal data for reasons relating to your particular situation. In such a case, the Data Controller shall no longer process the personal data, unless the Data Controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override your interests, rights and freedoms, or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

Right to a remedy

You may lodge a complaint with the Data Controller's data protection officer regarding the processing of your personal data, using the contact details provided above. You may also file a complaint with the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (address: 1055 Budapest, Falk Miksa utca 9-11., postal address: 1363

Budapest, Pf. 9., e-mail address: www.ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu), as a supervisory authority, if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR; and you may also apply to court if you consider that your rights under the GDPR have been violated as a result of the improper processing of your personal data.

Fulfillment of data subject requests

Your request to exercise your rights will be fulfilled free of charge, unless your request is clearly unfounded or excessive, in particular due to its repetitive nature, and for additional copies of your personal data processed by you, for which the Data Controller may charge a reasonable fee based on administrative costs.

Your request to exercise your rights will be fulfilled electronically, if you have submitted your request electronically, unless you request otherwise.
